This website is very modern and organized. GFWC is prominently displayed, linked, and defined. Sections are organized within boxes, which helps with readability. Pictures are happy and active. Meetings and events are easily found and their Twitter and Facebook feeds are displayed. And this is just on the Home Page! The site includes organizational history, quick facts, contact information, projects, and the next meeting date is at the very top of the each page.
